Home banking payment instructions:

1. **Log** into your bank or online bill pay website.
2. **Add** the new payee: NYC DOF Property Tax. Enter your account number, which is your boro, block and lot, as it appears here: 1-01200-0011 . You may also need to enter the address for the Department of Finance. The address is P.O. Box 680, Newark NJ 07101-0680.
3. **Schedule** your online payment using your checking or savings account.

When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us either to use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction.



If you own income producing property, you must file a Real Property Income and Expense Statement or a Claim of Exclusion unless you are exempt by law. The deadline to file is June 3, 2020. Failure to file will result in penalties and interest, which will become a lien on your property if they go unpaid. If your property is on a tax block that ends in the number "0", you will need to comply by December 31, 2020.
