- 2. **Add** the new payee: NYC DOF Property Tax. Enter your account number, which is your boro, block and lot, as it appears here: 3-05663-0014. You may also need to enter the address for the Department of Finance. The address is P.O. Box 680, Newark NJ 07101-0680.
- 3. **Schedule** your online payment using your checking or savings account.

When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us either to use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction.

If you own property in a commercial district with a ground floor or second floor storefront unit that was vacant or owner-occupied for any time period in 2021, you must register information about this space at www.nyc.gov/rpie. The deadline to register this information is June 1, 2022. Failure to do so will result in penalties and interest, which will become a lien on your property if they go unpaid. If you would like a payment agreement for your outstanding property taxes, we now offer a monthly payment agreement as well as the semi-annual and quarterly agreements.
