2. **Add** the new payee: NYC DOF Property Tax. Enter your account number, which is your boro, block and lot, as it appears here: 4-05581-0019 . You may also need to enter the address for the Department of Finance. The address is P.O. Box 680, Newark NJ 07101-0680.
3. **Schedule** your online payment using your checking or savings account.
