Change In Property Tax Bill Based On New Tax Rate

- 1. **Log** into your bank or online bill pay website.
- 2. Add the new payee: NYC DOF Property Tax. Enter your account number, which is your boro, block and lot, as it appears here: 4-13294-0004. You may also need to enter the address for the Department of Finance. The address is P.O. Box 680, Newark NJ 07101-0680.
- 3. **Schedule** your online payment using your checking or savings account.

When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us either to use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction.
